



Regulations of Submission and Admission for Non-Iraqi Students at University of Diyala for the Academic Year 2022-2023

First: Requirements of Non-Iraqi Students Application

1. **Master Degree:** The applicant must have a bachelor's degree in the specialization announced in the scholarship and in accordance with the scientific background required for the master's program or an equivalent certificate with the confirmation letter by the Department of Scholarships and Cultural Relations.
2. **Doctoral Degree:** The applicant must have a master's degree in the specialization announced in the scholarship and in accordance with the scientific background required for the doctoral program or an equivalent degree with the confirmation letter by the Department of Scholarships and Cultural Relations.
3. The applicant's grade point average for a high diploma or master's degree should not be less than (65%).
4. The applicant's grade point average for a doctorate degree should not be less than (70%).
5. Every applicant wishes to enroll in postgraduate studies must submit English Language Proficiency Proof in (IBT) TOEFL or IELTS or its equivalent, provided that the certificate is valid for two years from the date of issuance. In case of not having certificate in English proficiency, the applicant must pass the English language proficiency exam conducted by the university.
6. The scholarship is limited in duration of time, and any extension of the study will be for tuition fees.



Second: The documents required for submission and admission

The applicant must provide the university with the documents listed below:

1. Study documents certified by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs of the applicant's country and the Iraqi embassy or cultural attaché in the applicant's country.
 - a. A high school certificate certified by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Ministry of Education, and a bachelor's degree certified by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research / Department of Scholarships and Cultural Relations in concerned with a master's study.
 - b. Bachelor and Master certificates certified by the Ministry of Foreign Affairs and the Ministry of Higher Education and Scientific Research/Department of Scholarships and Cultural Relations in concerned with the doctoral study.
2. A passport valid for a period of no less than two years from the date of initial admission.
3. Research outline (research proposal)
4. Two Recommendation letters by full - Professors in the field of specialization.
5. Identification documents (ID).
6. Certificates of No Criminal Conviction, a health certificate issued by the country of applicant, and a medical re-examination in Iraq after acceptance.
7. A written commitment under which the applicant undertakes to abide by the laws, regulations, instructions in Iraq.

Third: Tuition fees for non-Iraqi students accepted on their own private expense category



The annual tuition fees for students admitted and continuing to study on their own private expense, according to specializations and studies, as shown in the table below:
